

New mental health helpline launched

Chief Minister Sheila Dikshit has launched a 24-hour Mental Health Helpline started by the Vandrevala Foundation Mental Health Initiative-India. The helpline has been started by Vandrevala Foundation in association with The Emmanuel Hospital Association, St. Stephen's Hospital and the Mar Thoma Church.

The launch of the helpline in Delhi is part of the Foundation's vision to reach out and provide medical assistance to a large number of patients, specially the underprivileged.
